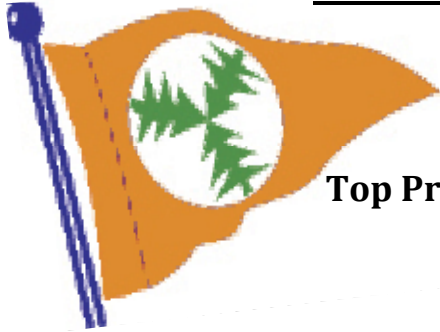
Welcome to the 'club' Bruce Jones, This is what he has to share with us:

I had always wanted to sail growing up in Idaho, but I didn't get access to a sail boat until I worked at a summer camp. They had a 19' un-ballasted sloop I would take out whenever possible. Without instruction, we just adjusted the sails as needed to go as fast as possible. It was an amazing experience that stayed with me. Twenty years later, I decided that I wanted a boat of my own and purchased a Cascade 29 from the original owner in Bellingham. It had been neglected for quite a while, although from the log book, it had been very active during the 80's. I took it out a few times before sailing it down to Commencement Bay. I was to sail it to Port Townsend,

then motored it the rest of the way. Since then we have been sailing it out on over-nighters occasionally to either Quartermaster Harbor or Blake Island. I probably have more hours working on the boat than actually sailing it.

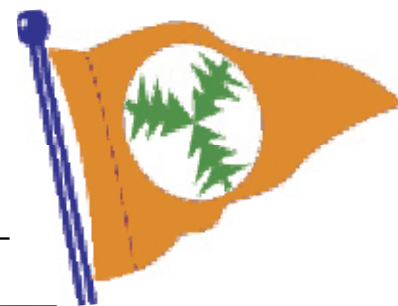

***Note Amended New Sailing Instructions: Replaces existing Commodore's Trophy Sailing Instructions in 2008 TTPYC Racing Handbook:**

- 4
- Eligibility:** All boats that meet Coast Guard safety equipment requirements.
All owners or skippers are eligible to register for and participate in TTPYC Commodore's Trophy Race. For this event, off-the-cuff handicaps will be issued (PHRF NW Performance ratings) as needed, and US Sailing sail numbers need not be displayed. (*Please call the registrar ASAP if your yacht needs a rating issued.
A minimum of two crew members on each boat.
- Start Line:** Start between the TTPYC Committee Boat and start mark K north of the Des Moines Marina keeping K mark to port.
OR Start between the TTPYC Committee on shore (end of fishing pier) and start mark K north of Des Moines Marina keeping K mark to starboard.
Note: A one place penalty will be assessed to any boat that is over early. Do not come back to the line to re-start.
- Race Rules:** US Sailing rules as modified by the TTPYC Handbook and this notice.
- Course:** KCJKCJK Leave start mark as specified above and all remaining marks to port. (Approx.: Fishing Pier, 3Tree Pt., Point Robinson, Fishing Pier 2 times around)
- Finish Line:** Finish between K mark and the Committee boat or Committee on shore (end of fishing pier) leaving K mark to port.
- Distance:** For Handicapping purposes, the course length is established at 18.2 nautical miles (unless course is shortened).
- Shortening Course:** If course is shortened, it shall be shortened for all PHRF yachts at the same mark. (Necessary for the overall prize of the Gold Burgee.) Cruising yachts may be shortened at any mark of the course.
- Start Time:** Warning: 09:30
First Start 09:35
- Time Limit:** No yacht shall finish later than 16:00
- Race Entry Fee: \$15.00**

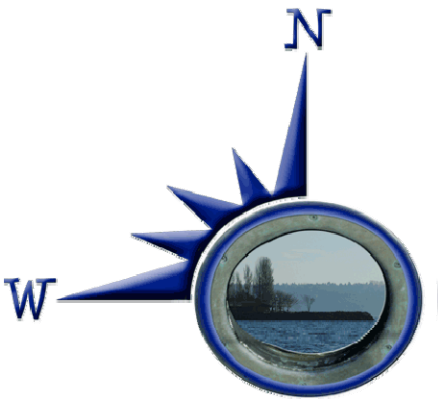
